Metro Updates- Presentation by Frank Quon, Executive Director-Highway Programs Mr. Quon provided status on a variety of projects that are currently in progress: Gold Line Foothill Extension: Phase 2A & 2B, Regional Connector Transit Corridor, Highway Projects, Alameda Corridor East Grade Separation Program, San Gabriel Valley projects, State Route 710 North Project Study Area, CFP-Signal Synchronization and Bus Speed Improvements, and Zero Emissions Vehicles.
- 7. Colby Fire: Post Fire/Lessons Learned Presentation by Jerry L. Burke, Assistant Public Works Director/City Engineer, City of Glendora

The Colby Fire was on January 16, 2014. The fire impacted the foothills in Glendora as the threat of an upcoming storm was predicted. The City of Glendora jumped into action by using social media to inform public of status, they set up the EOC and an Emergency Evacuation Center in advance of the storm. In less than 84 hours, City installed over 1.6 miles of k-rails on approximately 20 streets. They also handed out over 50,000 sand bags. Glendora reached out to other foothill cities that previously were affected by such events. The city was commended on how quickly they reacted and how proactive they were prior to the storm.
