PRESENTATIONS

6. California Home Energy Renovation Opportunity (HERO) Program

D. Reilich presented on this program, which allows property owners to finance energy efficiency and renewable projects to be paid back on their property tax bill. To date, 7,400 applications have been approved for \$216 million worth of projects. SGVCOG Governing Board adopted the HERO program in April 2013 and directed staff to actively promote the program within the region. Cities are advised to contact SGVCOG staff for questions or issues that may arise during the program implementation.

7. High Speed Rail

M. Boehm from California High Speed Rail Authority (CHSRA) presented an update on the nation's first high-speed rail system planning process. By 2029, the system will run from San Francisco to Los Angeles. In San Gabriel Valley, CHSRA will continue coordinating with regional partners and intends to present design enhancements to local impacted cities later this fall.
